The Fairgrounds is Right Out Our Backdoor

The Ozark Empire Fairgrounds (OEF) has so much more to offer the community than the amazing summertime fair experience we've come to know. According to Aaron Owen, General Manager of the fairgrounds there are so many other things than what we normally think about when we think fairgrounds. For instance, there are classic car shows, street machine nationals, gun shows, flea markets and concerts throughout the year. So whether it's the fair or at any other time, Owen said, "we have a lot of competition, so we try to do something special, something you won't normally see right out your back door." One of the things that is behind the scenes at the fairgrounds that the public may not think about is their currently expanding catering service, which is available for off site catering within a 1 mile radius of Springfield. Something that is really special right now is the Annex remodel project, which the OEF is currently looking for donor or sponsorship opportunities that would come with naming rights. The presence of OEF is probably more valuable to our community than many people may realize, and according to Owen we'll get a picture of just how important when "an economic impact study will be conducted starting in September this year," - right after the 2017 fair which runs July 27 to August 5th.
