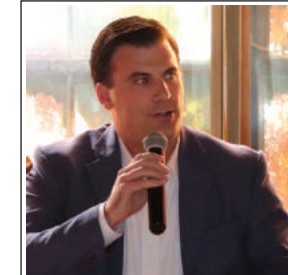

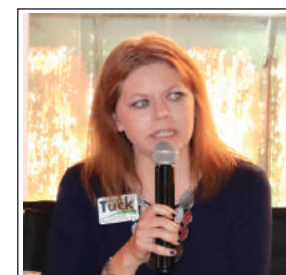

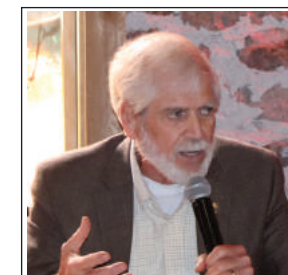

Get Plenty of Rest: One of the proven benefits of a vacation that is sure to improve our well-being is making sure to get all the sleep we need during our time off.


Disengage the Brain: By challenging yourself with a new skill or routine that is out of the usual mental for you, you'll go back to work refreshed.
